Movie Master for Windows also comes with five formats: film production and submission, sitcom production and submission, and play formats which are easily configured to your own needs by using the **Edit Script Format** dialog box.

Movie Master for Windows also comes with a Help System that makes answering question easy. By using Find+™ you can search the Help System for a topic you need help with. In addition, Context Sensitive Help allows you to click on item, such as a toolbar button, you would like to learn more about.
